About European Society for Marine Biotechnology

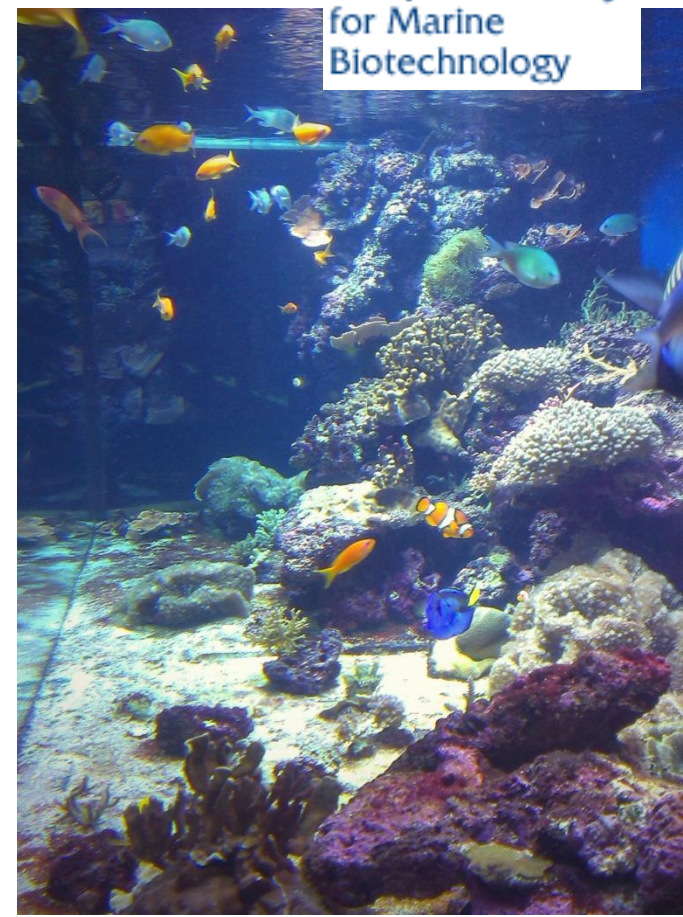
